

# Community Pain-a-thon Safety Protocols

## Volunteers

Volunteers will need to do the following before coming out for prep or paint day:

- Check temperature at home
- Pack a snack and lunch
- Pack water bottles (recommended to keep them in a cooler)
- Bring hand sanitizer and/or moist towelettes to keep in the car for when you take a break and for the end of the day
- Bring your own sunscreen and insect repellent
- Bring a face mask to wear and an extra to keep in the car

Habitat for Humanity will provide personal protective equipment (PPE) including: hand washing products, paper towels, face masks, gloves and hand sanitizer at each house. We ask that you bring your own hand sanitizer and wipes to use once you return to your vehicle for lunch or at the end of the day. We also are unable to provide food or water. As recommended above, we ask each volunteer to pack snacks, lunch and water for their own consumption.

## Team Leaders

Team leaders will need to do the following at the start of prep and paint days:

- Follow all of the requirements for volunteers as listed above.
- Greet volunteers, ask each one how they are feeling. Observe volunteers for symptoms.
- Require volunteers to wear face masks properly including covering their nose and mouth. Turn away anyone who is not willing to wear a mask immediately.
- Strictly adhere to team size restrictions.
- Make volunteers aware of the location of the PPEs. Offer gloves which are provided as part of the PPE.
- Assign 1 person to complete the sign in sheet to avoid sharing the writing utensil and clipboard.
- Volunteers to complete waivers before arrival, gathered along with the sign-in sheets in the envelope provided or some other no-touch method.
- Discuss plan for social distancing.
- Explain that volunteers are allowed to return to their vehicle for snacks and water as needed, and at break/lunchtime.
- Ask volunteers not to share painting equipment and supplies. If sharing must occur, please clean the equipment or supplies before sharing it with the other volunteer.
- Please inform volunteers, they will not be able to enter the house to use the restroom and should find a public restroom to use.

## Tasks to complete mid-day

- Encourage hand sanitizing prior to lunch.
- Remind volunteers to remain at least 6 feet apart while eating.
- Remind volunteers of safety protocols when they return from lunch.

## Tasks to complete at the end of the day

- Encourage hand sanitizing prior to leaving the site.
- Dispose of all paper towels from hand drying into the garbage bag and place near the homeowner's trash.
