Through our comprehensive spectrum of residential and community based programs we are building strong families and effectively addressing the issues that so often lead to abuse and neglect. Our programs promote child safety, positive parenting, education, and mental health, and improve the healthy functioning of families. Our eight programs span six locations, serving over 7,000 children and 4,000 families each year, giving them hope a better tomorrow.

We have been incredibly happy recipients of Team Giving's community services since 2016 during their year of founding. If you are unfamiliar, Mercy Multiplied is a non-profit organization that exists to transform the lives and restore the hope of young women between the ages of 13-32. We provide free of charge residential care, Christian counseling and life skills training for girls who face life-controlling issues such as: eating disorders, self-harm, addictions, depression, unplanned pregnancy and physical and sexual abuse, including victims of sex trafficking. Due to our sensitive nature we do not have many of the common volunteer roles in our organization that a lot of nonprofits have to offer. Even knowing this Team Giving has come alongside us and helped fulfill some really unique roles we have had in the past.

Throughout our four years of working together the staff have streamlined every process of their time and efficiently found a way to fulfill the needs we had. They have always been incredibly helpful and professional. Over the years we have worked with approximately 60 of their volunteers on 10 events ranging from luncheons, 5Ks, and private parties. My favorite part of Team Giving is the friendly staff and how easy they make this process for us. By way of introduction, I am the founder and director of Hearts Landing Ranch, a nonprofit that serves families and their loved ones navigating emotional trauma with Equine Assisted Learning. Many of our participants have suffered physical violence, exploitation and emotional abuse.

We also have a Seed to Stomach Gardening Program and finally we are building a community around foster, adoptive and local families with various community events such as movie and bonfire nights, pumpkin patch and Christmas sing along and tree give away.

For approximately two years, Team Giving has come along side Hearts Landing Ranch with a stream of volunteers to help us serve at risk youth.

Team Giving is proactive in their mission to help nonprofits by continuing to inquire about upcoming needs and events we have, so they can help us in our mission.

Also, Team Giving is thoughtful in the goals and needs of both the nonprofit and organizations who want to serve by ensuring there is a good “fit.”

A small example of the variety and quality of volunteers and the work they did:

- International Students all over Northern California helped build the “lasagna” garden.
- Kaiser Administrators rebuilt bird houses and prepped the herb beds and washed horses.
- Old Navy on multiple trips has painted the garden shed and painted the clinic bleachers.
- Court Ordered volunteers who were committed to hard outside work, prepped for the fall events.
- California Conservation Core was instrumental in setting up for the Pumpkin Patch event, unloading hundreds of pumpkins and moving tons of hay... then

they stayed throughout the event to paint the kids' faces, have fun and clean up.

- Blast Analytics & Marketing brought 32 people for "spring cleaning," the seed to stomach garden and laid down 50 yards of wood chips.

Team Giving has provided Hearts Landing enormously valuable resources we could not have done ourselves, given our heavy schedule of mentoring youth and their families, community events and rescuing horses.

Because of Team Giving's support, just this last fall, we were able to accomplish 4 major events and serve 1,000 more people in the foster, adoptive and surrounding communities!

Team Giving has been a wonderful partner and invaluable resource!

We are the only emergency housing solution for families in Placer County and the work they do to assist us in serving our guests is immeasurable. The work they did to our campus in repairing and beautifying the grounds is tangible proof that the vulnerable population of unsheltered individuals and families we serve are not invisible to the community and deserve dignity and respect. The impact of having a place safe, like our shelter, when our residents are in crisis is wonderful, but having it be a campus of collaboration with their agency where our guests get to see that they aren't a forgotten or dismissed population, is truly a gift for all. The curb painting that Team Giving volunteers completed for our courtyard and the grounds, let our guests see that they strive for their safety. They see the proof that they can reach to be a part of the community that helps them while they stay at The Gathering Inn. The canopies that their volunteers installed in the interior courtyard are used every day to provide shade in the heat while they check into the shelter at night and keep the rain off their backs during the winter.
