





- #1** Love, INC. offers “To-go” Bags. People struggling with hunger may RING our doorbell Monday-Friday (10AM-3PM) and a To-go bag is given. The bags include enough food to help for an entire day . Often the bag include a fresh sandwich prepared by a local church, organization, or group. Always included is shelf sustainable food.
- #2** Love, INC. offers homeless and/or hungry people a warm meal every Tuesday and Thursday night from 6 to 7 PM. And in winter months, Love, INC. offers a warm meal every night of the week!
- #3** Love, INC. provides emergency food boxes. These boxes are given to individuals that express a need for food to take their home, a hotel room, or often for them to eat in their car or campsite. The first time a person asks, the food is freely given. However, Love, INC. is seeking to build relationships and may make an attempt to gain information to make referrals to provide long term solutions. Referrals are required to continue to receive these food boxes.
- #4** Love, INC. provides supplemental food boxes. The staff speaks conducts a phone intake and food is prepared to meet the needs of the household. Love, INC also connects clients to other services they may be interested in like budgeting, parenting, job or housing counseling, and so much more.
- #5** Love, INC. offers hotel bags of food for individuals and families who have called and received a referral. These persons are housing insecure and are going to a hotel due to homelessness.
- #6** Love, INC. hosts truck load distributions of food. Love, INC coordinates with a distributor to bring a truck of fresh USDA food through a program like “ Farmers to Families” to various locations and offer drive thru pick up. Included in the boxes are fresh milk, dairy, eggs, produce, and meat!
- #7** Love, INC. **YOU CAN BECOME INVOLVED BY REFERRING A CLIENT TO LOVE, INC!** If you need more information please email Love, INC at loveincofmiddelmarva@gmail.com to become a trusted partner.

CHILD ADVOCATES NEEDED

The Office of the Child Advocate- Court Appointed Special Advocate Program (CASA) of Delaware is expanding its efforts to represent the interests of abused and neglected children. The program is seeking qualified adults to serve as CASA volunteers.

CASA volunteers are trained members of the community who are appointed by a Family Court Judge to be a voice for Delaware's abused and neglected children in court proceedings. The CASA volunteer conducts an independent investigation into the child's life and provides information and recommendations to the Judge. CASA volunteers work with attorneys, social workers, and family members to attain a safe and permanent home for each child.

CASA volunteers have varied professional, educational and ethnic backgrounds. They are selected on the basis of their objectivity, competence and commitment. Each volunteer accepted into the program must complete 30 hours of initial training. Casework supervision is provided by full time Program Coordinators.


