ACTS OF SERVICE CHALLENGE IDEAS

- Plant flowers or a vegetable garden in a communal neighborhood area
- Pick up and deliver groceries or medicine for someone in need
- Gather up books and unused school supplies to donate to your local school or library
- Organize a "spring cleaning" project and donate your unused items that are in good condition to a local charity
- Participate in a DIY volunteering project at <u>www.handsonmiami.org/diy</u>
- Take time to share your education and skills with others who can benefit from them. Lead an online painting class, fitness session or professional development training session to help others learn new skills
- Sign up with an organization to make wellness calls to home-bound seniors
