



DO YOU KNOW A VOLUNTEER WHO DESERVES THIS AWARD?

The Minoru Yasui Community Volunteer Award was created in 1976 by Denver's Commission on Community Relations and business leaders. The Award honors individuals within the metropolitan area who have made outstanding contributions through volunteerism, but who have received little recognition.

The Award is named for the late Minoru Yasui, Director of Denver's Commission on Community Relations from 1967 to 1983. Since its inception in 1976, the Award Committee has honored more than 400 special volunteers for their selfless efforts in the community.

Any person of any age who lives in the seven-county Denver metro area is eligible to receive the Award, however, individuals may not nominate themselves.

Awards are given each month from January through November and recipients are honored with the following:

- **A substantial monetary award (subject to Committee guidelines) to a nonprofit agency of the recipient's choice**
- **A public award ceremony arranged exclusively for the recipient**
- **Proclamation from the Mayor of the City and County of Denver**
- **Commemorative plaque**
