Commitment: At least biweekly

PURPOSE:

Naomi Family Program houses women and women with children (usually ages 10 and younger). In the mornings Tuesday – Thursday the women have class. We need volunteers to help support our on-site child programming. Some days we may have one child and others we may have thirty children on campus, some days we may have none on campus and it is a day to focus on prep.

RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE:

1. Interacting with the children through activities that include, but are not limited to: crafts, games, and reading
2. Helping with preparation for other days such as assisting in preparing for crafts
3. Cleaning toys

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Pass a background check (paid and provided by Union Gospel Mission Twin Cities)
2. Experience with children who have experienced trauma
3. Ability to be flexible in the moment

WORKING CONDITIONS & PHYSICAL EFFORT:

- Ability to lift 10-15 lbs.
- Ability to bend, sit, and stand
- This is a sitting and standing role in a home shelter environment.

TRAINING:

- Orientation and training is provided by NFP staff.
- More training opportunities may be provided in the future.
