



Corporate Service Program Sponsorship Overview

Jersey Cares is experienced at crafting strong corporate-nonprofit partnerships that benefit the entire community. As a Jersey Cares Corporate Partner, your company will receive customized volunteer project planning services for your employees, clients, vendors, family members and anyone else you choose.

Customized Volunteer Projects

Our partners enjoy a multi-faceted partnership with Jersey Cares that provides them with tailored community service opportunities. Companies are eligible to benefit from individualized corporate volunteer initiatives designed expressly for their employees and created specifically to accommodate their needs and schedules.

Project Planning Capacity

While Jersey Cares does not charge a fee for project planning services, we do attempt to utilize our project planning capacity in the most logical and appropriate way possible. Because our partners enable us to provide this service, we prioritize our capacity according to sponsorship level. Jersey Cares asks for a sponsorship level from your company based on the size of your requested volunteer project. These levels are calculated at a rate of **\$150 per volunteer**. Below are sample sponsorship levels.

<u>Sponsorship Level</u>	<u>Service Project Size</u>
\$3,750	25 Volunteers
\$7,500	50 Volunteers
\$15,000	100 Volunteers

Note: Sponsorship will increase for greater number of volunteers based on the scale above. Sponsorship does not include meals or transportation costs.

Exclusive Project Management

Depending on their areas of interest, our corporate partners benefit from Jersey Cares's expertise in one or more of our program areas and have the opportunity to give back to their community through team-based projects. Jersey Cares works with our partners to plan projects that meet their needs, whether one-time efforts or a calendar of customized projects, creating a sophisticated volunteer program that meets the needs of each company (see Jersey Cares Customized Corporate Service Menu for full list of projects).

In every project, Jersey Cares will:

- Identify an organization or location capable of working with employee groups.
- Determine an appropriate amount of volunteer work based on the number of volunteers participating and time allotted.
- Provide a project scope in advance for internal distribution to employee volunteers.
- Order all needed supplies and ensure they are on site and organized prior to the group's arrival, provide on-site management of the project, including a welcome of the volunteers, managing registration, giving an overview of the project and its importance, and conducting follow-up evaluation to guide future planning.
- Manage an online advance registration process including a reminder email with project directions and contact numbers. (upon request)
- Coordinate water, lunch and transportation. (upon request)
- Craft communication materials for the corporate partner to distribute internally promoting the day. (upon request)
