



Supply List*

- Cotton Fabric
- Rope elastic
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Sewing Machine & Thread



How to:

1. **Advise your network of the project.** Encourage your family, friends, and co-workers who are also comfortable with sewing to take part in the project.
2. **Purchase and/or collect supplies needed.** Make sure you have enough to make at least 2 face masks to earn 2 service hours. We understand it may not be easy to access/purchase supplies at this time, so please do so safely. If you are having trouble, please contact us for suggestions.
PLEASE NOTE: We will only give a maximum of 10 service hour per participant, but you are welcome to make more than 5 masks.
3. **Create your page face masks.** Detailed, step-by-step instructions (useful links) are listed below.
4. **Email photo/video proof of your completed project.** Send all information to Zakiya Becca, zakiya@handsonbroward.org or 954-233-1300.

Project Instructions: ***Be sure any fabric design is placed horizontally.*

1. Gather your supplies. You can make two sizes: Adult or Child
2. Put right sides of cotton fabric together
 - Cut 9x6 (Adult) or 7.5 x 5 (Child)
3. Starting at the center of the bottom edge, sew to the first corner, stop. Sew the elastic with the edge out into the corner. A few stitches forward and back will hold this.
4. Sew to the next corner, stop, and bring the other end of the same elastic to the corner and sew a few stitches forward and back.
5. Now sew across that top of the mask to the next corner. Again, put an elastic with the edge out.
6. Sew to the next corner and sew in the other end of the same elastic.
7. Sew across the bottom leaving about 1.5" to 2" open. Stop, cut the thread. Turn inside out.
8. Pin 3 tucks on each side of the mask. Make sure the tucks are the same direction
9. Sew around the edge of the mask twice.
