Supply List

Project Instructions

1. **Gather all the necessary supplies.** Please keep in mind that you may send multiple emails your pen pal.
2. **Write your letter.** Remember address the receiver (ie. Dear John, or Hello Sally,) and sign it at the end (ie. Sincerely, Mary or Best Wishes, Paul)
3. **Spell Check.** Don't forget to look over your letter to ensure that things to not get lost in translation.

If you wish to receive credit for school or a formal volunteering program, you will be required to send your photos or video proof to HandsOn Broward.
