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Board Impact Program for Nonprofits in Need of Board Members

This program matches nonprofit organizations seeking trained board members. BIP is a training and matching service program.



Thursday, April 29, 2027 "Speed Matching" takes place from 2:30 -4:00 p.m.

BOARD IMPACT HAS TWO MAIN COMPONENTS

1. Teaching the principles of responsible and impactful board service.
2. Optional: Matching leaders to serve effectively on nonprofit boards.

ELIGIBILITY 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations in the Alexandria area may apply if they have a Board of Directors, D&O insurance, a minimum annual budget of \$100,000, and a mission that benefits the Alexandria community. VolALX does not accept nonprofits that promote specific religious or political beliefs.

DEADLINE: Complete the application by April 9, 2027, and make your \$50 payment. The application will require approximately 30 minutes to complete and should be completed by the organization's leadership (Executive Director or CEO).

MANDATORY TRAINING FOR NEW NONPROFITS: To ensure the best board placements, prospective nonprofits must first attend a Mandatory Virtual Board training at 10:00 am on April 13, 2027, for all nonprofit Executive Directors and/or Nominating Chairs.

TIMING OF NONPROFIT SELECTION

Mid-April: VolALX will match prospective Board candidates to nonprofit participants. The goal is that participating candidates receive between 1 and 3 matches.

April 29: Prospective Board candidates will attend a day-long in-person Board Impact training. Participating nonprofits will join the 1-3 prospective candidates to do a "speed matching."

Participating nonprofits will be guaranteed a minimum of one potential Board candidate with the possibility of a second potential candidate.
