Prior to Girl Scouts, Natalye was the executive vice president and chief operating officer of the Kimmel Center Inc. from 2006-2010. She has held multiple leadership positions in School District of Philadelphia and the Chicago

Public Schools system. Her work in education began as a regional attorney with the United States Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights, from 1989 to 1994. Natalye began her career in private practice as a litigation attorney in 1986, admitted to the Illinois Bar and U.S. District Court, N.D.IL. Natalye earned her Juris Doctor from DePaul University College of Law, and a Bachelor of Science degree from Florida A&M University.
