Business Connections

- 10 Projects Implemented
- 334 volunteers engaged, serving Alexandria Community Shelter, Community of Hope, Four Mile Run Conservatory Foundation, The Campagna Center, and The Child & Family Network Centers
- 638 hours served

Youth Engaged in Service Program

- 162 volunteers engaged in service, completing 942 hours.
- Engaged middle and high school students learning about city nonprofits and how to make a difference.

Court Services Program

- Engaged with 282 clients, who served 11,270 hours

Volunteer Reception Center (VRC)

- 63 trained Volunteers who are ready to serve the city during an emergency/disaster

Snow Buddy Program

- 79 trained volunteers served 111 seniors, shoveling snow and removing ice during the snow season.

Board Impact Training & Matching Program

A training for people interested in serving on Boards and Commissions, including a matching service.

40 individuals trained in Board Service across two classes; all 25 organizations successfully matched with new members.
