



Workforce Volunteer Program with Volunteer Alexandria

Details for Workforce Volunteer Participants

Summary: Volunteer Alexandria and The Department of Community and Human Services are partnering to help SNAP/Medicaid recipients meet new federal work requirements. For those opting to complete requirements through volunteering, Volunteer Alexandria provides a platform to find, register, and track volunteer service hours. Participants are referred to as **Workforce Volunteers**.

For Individuals interested in registering as a Workforce Volunteer:

- Register at Volunteer Alexandria (www.volunteeralexandria.org/workforce)
- For the registration question, “Are you a Workforce Volunteer?” select YES.
- Once registered, find and select volunteer opportunities.
 - First, visit www.volunteeralexandria.org/wvo to view a list of opportunities specifically highlighted for Workforce Volunteers. Sign up for the options that fit your schedule, interests, and abilities.
 - Or browse our full database. **Of note:** It is highly recommended to filter your search by **Date & Time Specific**. This will highlight choices with specific times to serve and **does not require additional coordination**.
