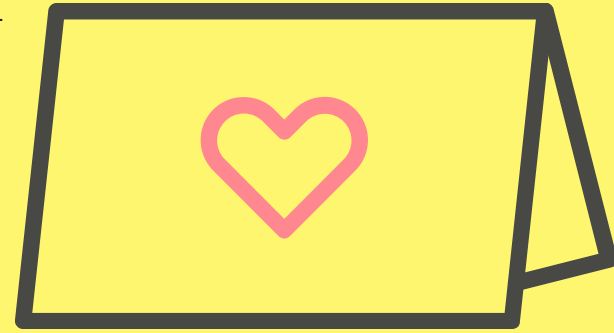


Greeting Cards for seniors



DIY SERVICE PROJECT

Description

These homemade greeting cards are the perfect way to brighten someone's day. Whether you donate them to a nursing home, meal delivery program, or a senior neighbor, you will show someone how truly special they are!

Supplies

- Markers, Crayons, or Colored Pencils
- Construction Paper
- Envelopes



Budget

- Construction Paper: \$3.50 for 50 sheets
- Markers, Crayons, or Colored Pencils: \$1.80-\$3.25
- Envelopes: \$12 for 100 envelopes

Total: \$17 for 50 Cards (\$0.34 per card)

Directions

1. Fold the construction paper in half horizontally.
2. Get creative and decorate the card with your own personal greeting! You can use greetings to celebrate the seasons (ex. Hello Summer!) or any upcoming holidays.
3. Once you're done decorating the cards, donate them to brighten someone's day!
