- Scissors
- Hand sanitizer
- Soap

3. Place a card in the kit that says: "For emergencies dial 911."

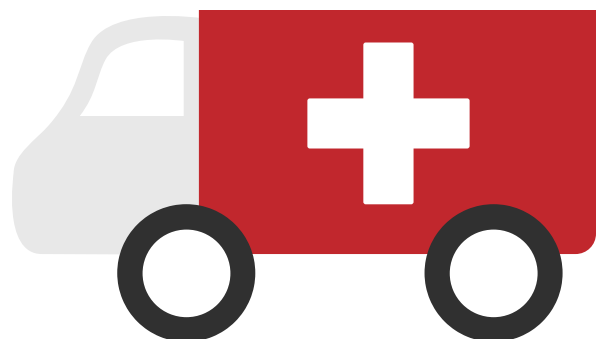
